

WCTC Radiography Petition Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is applying for admission to the Radiography program and petitioning the same thing?

A: No. When you apply for admission, you are applying to the college for acceptance into the Radiography program. Petitioning occurs when you are ready to take Radiography core classes.

Q: Do I have to be admitted into the Radiography program before I petition?

A: Yes. Students must complete all admission steps and be admitted into the Radiography program prior to petitioning for Radiography core classes.

Q: How do I know when I am ready to petition?

A: You are ready to petition once you have completed, or are in the process of finishing, your final general education courses, the TEAS test and are ready to begin Radiography core classes the following fall.

Q: Are there specific times in which I can petition for Radiography core classes?

A: Yes. The petition window is once a year, March 1-14, for students who wish to begin Radiography core classes in fall.

Q: What specifically do I have to do in order to petition?

A: You must complete the electronic docuSign petition form and submit it along with the required documentation listed on the form during the petition window.

Q: Is there a test required to petition?

A: Yes. You must complete the TEAS test at MATC and achieve a minimum cumulative score of 70 and also a score of 70 in Math and General A&P.

Q: I missed the window to petition but I have all of my general education requirements done. Will you accept a late petition?

A: No. Late petitions are not accepted.

Q: Where do I find the petition form?

A: The petition form will be available on the student portal under Student Announcements- Academic Announcements and on WCTC's Radiography web page approximately before the petition windows open.

Q: How many seats are there? How are seats awarded?

A: There are 8 seats awarded each year. Seats are awarded based on courses complete, testing complete and admission date.
