SouthEast Wisconsin Master Gardeners

The SouthEast Wisconsin Master Gardeners, Inc. is a nonprofit corporation that educates the public on horticulture principles, based upon University of Wisconsin recommendations and research. Master Gardener Volunteers are trained by UW-Extension specialists and agents in many aspects of horticulture. In return for their training, Master Gardener Volunteers help with educational programs in horticulture and a wide variety of community service projects.

The WCTC students receiving this scholarship must be committed to focus on hardscaping and landscaping through masonry studies. The WCTC Foundation is very honored to be the steward of this scholarship.

The Maria J. Jensen Memorial Scholarship Fund

Maria J. Jensen led a remarkable life, inspired many, and has remained with her family and friends through her extraordinary legacy. To recognize her belief in education, a scholarship has been established through the WCTC Foundation.

In 1997, at age 54, Maria received an Associate Degree in Accounting from WCTC. To honor her memory, her husband, Don, and her sons, Gary, Dennis and Charles, established the "Maria J. Jensen Memorial Scholarship Fund." Maria's family said that they are grateful to WCTC for the impact it had on their wife/mother's life and her self-esteem and hopes that through this scholarship, it will inspire more women to succeed both in their education and in the fulfillment of their goals.



Maria Jensen was born in Bornem, Belgium, and moved to the United States at age nine. Her family settled in St. Clair Shores, Michigan where she attended high school. In 1962, Maria worked at the Seattle World's Fair where she helped introduce the Belgian waffle to the American public, including Elvis Presley. She worked as a secretary for the automotive industry until she married her husband Don in 1964. They lived in Michigan, Illinois and Wisconsin. Mrs. Jensen was active in her community and was also an accomplished cook, active golfer, and fitness fanatic.

In her 50's, Mrs. Jensen decided to return to school to study accounting because she always loved math. During her time at WCTC, she formed strong relationships with her teachers and mentors and forged friendships with students in her classes, even those many years younger than her. She carried a 4.0 GPA and was inducted into Phi Theta Kappa, an achievement that made her proud for the rest of her life.

A Legacy That Keeps Giving ... Evelyn Huegel

This Spring, Evelyn Huegel will help a child learn his ABC's and make the transition to a new group in his child care center.

Evelyn passed away in October of 2010, but her commitment to excellent child care will continue because of the scholarships she provides through The Edward J. Evert Family Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Evelyn's scholarship fund supports WCTC students enrolled in the Early Childhood Education Associate Degree Program. Established in 1998, The Edward J. Evert Family Memorial Scholarship Fund, named for Evelyn's father, represents the largest endowment in the WCTC Foundation. This generous scholarship has provided 66 scholarships ranging from \$250 to \$1,500 depending on the individual student need.

Evelyn is remembered by her niece, Jean Schapp, and other nieces and nephews. Her commitment to children grew out of her professional career at Wisconsin Electric. Evelyn realized that the parents she worked with needed assurance that their children were safely cared for while they were working. She felt by supporting the educational advancement of child care workers it would result in better child care providers.

Ways To Give

There are several options which allow donors to support the students of WCTC:

Endowments

An endowment with the WCTC Foundation is an excellent tool for making a perpetual scholarship gift. An investment of \$10,000 establishes a named endowment to benefit a specific category of students or a field of study that has been chosen by the donor. To accomplish this goal, gift commitments may be completed over a five-year period. Scholarships are awarded beginning the semester after the \$10,000 goal is reached.

Named Scholarships

Named Scholarships are established to recognize a particular individual or organization. The purpose of the scholarship may be designed specifically by the donor. Honorary and memorial scholarships usually define a field of interest specifically related to the donor's motivation. All Named Scholarships are promoted to students with information about the source of funding and purpose of the scholarship.

Advised Funds

Another form of support is through an Advised Fund. An Advised Fund is used for the support of specific programs of a department or division and/or the support of students enrolled at WCTC. Donors designating their gifts to an Advised fund may restrict their gift to student assistance, staff development, materials, equipment, supplied, etc.

In-Kind Gifts

Each year, in-kind donations of equipment and services assist in enhancing the educational experiences of students at WCTC. In-kind giving is a unique and meaningful way to support the educational advancement of students and utilizes items that may have concluded their usefulness for business. In-kind donations can include: new products and inventory, production equipment, buildings, land, raw materials, machinery and tooling, office furniture and equipment, heavy equipment, vehicles, and services.
