## Program Description

The MSLA program is uniquely designed to enrich the experience of students looking to connect with the WCTC diverse community. The program assists new, transfer, and current students in their transition to WCTC, while building a multicultural campus community that is essential to student success. Furthermore, the program provides financial support for the academic year.

As a participant in this program, students will build strong relationships with their faculty/staff advisors and peer leaders, develop a strong cultural and academic identity, and become familiar with WCTC resources that will assist in their transition to WCTC. The programming, mentoring and support that is provided by the program, will assist students in building a foundation that will result in continued success beyond the first year and ultimately lead to graduation.

### **Selected Retention Program Participants will be required to:**

- Attend the MSLA Orientation: Monday, August 22, 2016 (8:00am – 4:30pm)
- Actively participate in social and cultural activities and workshops
- Meet weekly with a designated peer leader throughout each term
- Seek out financial resources for the upcoming academic year
- Maintain a minimum of a 2.5 GPA
- Meet on a regular basis with designated staff advisor

### **Eligibility**

- New students, transferring students, or current students that have completed less than 24 credits
- Admitted to Waukesha County Technical College or currently in the process of admission.
- Must be at least a part-time student with a minimum of 6 credit hours each term.
