Articulation Agreement

September 20, 2017

This articulation agreement establishes a cooperative relationship between Marian University (*Marian*) and Waukesha County Technical College that will assist both schools in better serving the educational needs of transfer students. The agreement sets forth policies and procedures by which Waukesha County Technical College students may become eligible to enroll in bachelor programs offered at Marian. The transfer policies described herein will be in effect upon date of signature for Waukesha County Technical College graduates.

General Terms

- Students who have not completed the associate degree are not guaranteed transferability of coursework, but instead will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- Students who receive an Associate of Applied Science Degree will have satisfied elective requirements in the Marian University General Education Curriculum; they must also satisfy requirements of the Core in the General Education Curriculum.
- Neither individual grades for classes nor GPA are transferable to Marian.
- Students must satisfy program requirements of the particular Marian University degree, curriculum major and/or minor selected.
- A minimum of 30-32 credits must be completed at Marian University.
- The student must earn from Marian at least 50% of the credits required for a major.
- The student must earn from Marian at least 30% of the credits required for a minor.
- At least 30 credits of upper level coursework must be completed toward the bachelor's degree except as noted herein.
- The following programs, as detailed in the attached transfer guides, are included in this articulation agreement
 1. WCTC Human Services to MU Community Health and Human Services
 2. WCTC Medical Assistant to MU Community Health and Human Services
 3. WCTC Health Information Technology to MUR Health Care Administration
 4. WCTC Human Services to MU Psychology
 5. WCTC Marketing to MU Marketing
 6. WCTC Criminal Justice to MU Criminal Justice

Renewal Terms

The agreement will be reviewed and renewed at five-year intervals, with content changes as deemed appropriate by the parties.



**EDUCATIONAL PARTNERSHIP
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
Marian University and Waukesha County Technical College**

Marian University, a private, non-profit, comprehensive institution of higher learning, is located in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, with outreach teaching centers in Appleton, Wisconsin and West Allis, Wisconsin. In addition to physical teaching centers, Marian University also offers classes and degrees through online delivery.

Marian University offers partner organizations special benefits and a tuition discount. The 10% tuition discount applies to all Waukesha County Technical College alumni and employees for all bachelor's and master's programs. If there is a critical mass (15) for an onsite cohort, Marian University will offer a 20% discount to Waukesha County Technical College alumni and employees for such a cohort.

In conjunction with this partnership MOU, Marian University will:

1. Marian University will offer a 10% tuition discount to all Waukesha County Technical College alumni and employees for bachelor's and master's programs (excluding the Ph.D. program and Institute of Professional Development)
2. Waive application fee for all Waukesha County Technical College alumni and employees.
3. Provide marketing materials and create landing site on Marian webpage to support internal promotion by Waukesha County Technical College faculty and staff.
4. If an onsite cohort is established, Waukesha County Technical College faculty may be able to teach in the program, and Marian University will rent classroom space at Waukesha County Technical College for an onsite. Students in the onsite will receive a 20% tuition discount.

In conjunction with this partnership MOU, Waukesha County Technical College will:

1. Internally promote Marian University's programs.
2. Provide assistance through Waukesha County Technical College advisors, staff and faculty to assist Waukesha County Technical College students transitioning to the programs.
3. If courses are run onsite, provide and maintain classroom facilities, and supportive technologies while assuring facilities are available and ready for use as scheduled.
4. Promote the programs on Waukesha County Technical College website with links to Marian's website for course schedules, e-books, registration, financial aid, etc.
5. Provide access to Library and Academic Support Services to the students enrolled in courses on the campus within normal hours of operation.
6. Allow Marian University representatives to make on-site visits to promote program within Waukesha County Technical College guidelines at pre-arranged times.

If students are eligible for more than one discount, the discount of greatest applicable value will be applied to their account. Students who enroll as part of this MOU are responsible for monitoring their billing statements. If the account does not accurately reflect the discount mentioned, the student should contact the Marian University Office of Business and Finance at 920.923.8101.

This partnership discount MOU is not exclusive. Both parties may enter into additional agreements as they see fit. This partnership discount MOU is automatically renewable on the anniversary of signature; however, it can be terminated by either party at any time.
