

Articulation Agreement

July 10, 2019

This articulation agreement establishes a cooperative relationship between Marian University (MU) and the Colleges of the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) that will assist both schools in better serving the educational needs of transfer students. The agreement sets forth policies and procedures by which WTCS students may become eligible to enroll in bachelor programs offered at Marian. The transfer policies described herein will be in effect upon date of signature for WTCS graduates that plan to enroll starting fall 2019.

General Terms


- Students who have not completed the associate degree are not guaranteed transferability of coursework, but instead will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- Neither individual grades for classes nor GPA are transferable to Marian.
- Students must satisfy program requirements of the particular Marian University degree, curriculum major and/or minor selected.
- A minimum of 30 credits must be completed at Marian University.
- The student must earn from Marian at least 50% of the credits required for a major.
- The student must earn from Marian at least 30% of the credits required for a minor.
- The following programs, as detailed in the attached transfer guides, are included in this articulation agreement
 1. WTCS Nursing to MU RN to BSN Completion Program

Renewal Terms

The agreement will be reviewed and renewed at five-year intervals, with content changes as deemed appropriate by the parties.

NOTE: Marian reserves the right to make policy revisions, which may affect the contents of this agreement due to changes in the curriculum or quality standards at Marian or WTCS.
