Statement and Conditions of Agreement:

- 1 Course equivalencies in this agreement are subject to change in the event that course curriculum of WCTC or MIAD undergo revision. In the event of curricular revision, notification of such revision will be made by the changing institution and will require review of equivalency and updating of this agreement.
- 2 Faculty from both programs will meet annually for the purposes of program review and curricular dialogue.
- 3 This agreement will automatically extend unless terminated by either party with six months prior written notification. Students enrolled at MIAD at the time of termination will be allowed to finish the program.
- 4 Students must complete the required WCTC courses with a minimum grade of a 'C' (C- not accepted for transfer credit).
- 5 Transfer students must complete all MIAD admissions requirements. Final decision on transfer credit and class standing will conform to the course equivalencies contained in this agreement.
- 6 Transfer students must complete a portfolio review with the Transfer Admissions Counselor and/or Communication Design faculty chair prior to admission.
- 7 All students admitted under this articulation agreement must complete the non-credit FYE132: 3D Lab Tutorial during the first semester of enrollment at MIAD.
- 8 Students are encouraged to keep all work from studio courses, all syllabi and a WCTC catalogue.
