

# Organizational Leadership - Bachelor of Applied Studies

The Bachelor of Applied Studies (B.A.S.) degree with a major in Organizational Leadership is specifically designed for students who have earned an applied associate degree from a technical college or other regionally accredited institution. This program is primarily an online bachelor's degree that offers an interdisciplinary education providing foundational leadership skills with a focus on communication, critical thinking, and problem-solving.

Students accepted into this program will be able to transfer coursework from any Wisconsin Technical College System campus or other regionally-accredited **two-year institution into UW-Green Bay as a block of 60 degree credits and enter the University as a junior.** Students complete a minimum of 60 additional credits to satisfy UW-Green Bay general education requirements, requirements for the Organizational Leadership major and all other degree requirements.
